Resolve, in Favor of Town of Milo.

Town of Milo; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,273.68 to be paid to the Town of Milo to reimburse the town for support and medical care furnished Sadie F. Angove.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1923 Sadie F. Angove was committed to Pineland Hospital and Training Center and remained there until September 7, 1962. During the time she was an inmate of Pineland her settlement was of course frozen.

In 1962 she went to work in the Warren Nursing Home in the Town of Warren as an employee and worked there for approximately one year. In reality Mrs. Angove was "loaned out" from Pineland while working at this nursing home. She was discharged from Pineland in 1963.

['] During the late summer of 1964 she was brought to Milo and left at the Milo town Hall by the people of the nursing home. Since that time she has remained in Milo at the expense of the Town of Milo, amounting to \$1,273.68.
