RESOLVE, to Reimburse Vernon Meldrum of Wilton for Well Damage by Highway Construction.

Vernon Meldrum; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$600 to be paid to Vernon Meldrum, of Wilton, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage to his well and loss of water supply caused by highway construction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In August, 1961, work on road construction (project No. F-025-1 (8)) on U. S. route #2 from Wilton toward Farmington (Wilton bypass) caused damage to Mr. Meldrum's well and loss of water supply.
