AN ACT Relating to Board Approval of School Administrative Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 213, amended. The first paragraph of section 213 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The board may approve the formation of School Administrative Districts ~~which had at least 300 resident secondary pupils educated at public expense in grades 9 through 12 as indicated in the last returns made to the commissioner under section 966~~ whenever 2 or more towns apply and support their application with an adequate study outlining the district proposals.'
