AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Construction of Eddy Bridge, an Interstate Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Eddy Bridge; funds for construction of. There is appropriated the sum of \$19,345.70 from the General Highway Fund as the state's share in constructing the Eddy Bridge located over Salmon Falls River between Berwick, Maine and Sommersworth, New Hampshire. The construction shall be done by the State Highway Commission.
