STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Snow Removal in Towns Exceeding Three Thousand Inhabitants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1001, amended. The last paragraph of section 1001 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The maintenance provisions of sections 705, 751, 1001, 1002, 1003, 1005, 1008 and 1011 shall not apply to those compact or built-up sections of state highway in cities or towns whose population according to the last U. S. census exceeds 5,000 inhabitants, except for maintenance of secondary federal aid projects, and the snow removal provisions shall not apply to those compact or built-up sections, and "compact areas" as determined by the commission, in which compact sections are intermittent and separated by a short interval or intervals of sections that are not compact, of state highway in cities or towns whose population according to the last U. S. census exceeds 2,000 3,000 inhabitants. The commission may take over the snow removal on such portions of controlled access highways within compact sections as it deems advisable.'
