RESOLVE, Authorizing the Erection of a Marker Honoring the Memory of the Reverend Peter Powers of Deer Isle.

Erection of marker authorized. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission shall erect and maintain a marker perpetuating the memory of the Revolutionary War Patriot, the Reverend Mr. Peter Powers, of Deer Isle, in a suitable location on state property on the Deer Isle side of the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge, in the County of Hancock; said marker to be furnished by the descendents of the Reverend Mr. Peter Powers at no expense to the State.
