IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Clerical Assistance for Justices of Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 102, amended. Section 102 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 102. Salary; expenses. Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of \$16,500. Section 4, relating to reimbursement of Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court for expenses incurred by them, shall apply to Justices of the Superior Court, including reimbursement for expenses incurred in employing clerical assistance but which in the aggregate shall not exceed a total sum of \$4,500 \$9,000 per year for all such clerical assistance.'
- **Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$3,375 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$4,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
