SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 420, L. D. 532, Bill, "An Act Relating to Improper Conditions for Industrial Safety."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined paragraph in section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'Every employer shall use care to provide reasonably safe work places, equipment, tools and working conditions for his employees. If, upon inspection, the commissioner or any authorized agent of the department shall find that an existing condition is such as to be injurious to the health of the persons employed or residing therein by reason of inadequate heating, lighting, ventilation or sanitary arrangement, or that reasonable safeguards for preventing accidents or injuries to those employed are not provided, he shall notify, in writing, the employer, proprietor or agent operating such work place to make, within 30 days, the alterations or additions by him deemed necessary for the reasonable safety and protection of the employees. In case of a condition deemed to be extraordinarily hazardous, the commissioner or any authorized agent may apply to any Justice of the Superior Court, in the county in which such hazard is alleged to exist, for injunctive relief for the immediate removal or abatement of said hazard.' "
