STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Hours of Moving Pictures on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 3207, amended. The first sentence of section 3207 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'In any municipality that shall vote as provided, it shall be lawful for any moving picture theater to have an exhibition of moving pictures on Sunday between the hours of \mathfrak{F} 1 p.m. and 11:30 p.m.'
