IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Ratifying the Ownership of Hungry Island by Town of Bremen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Ownership of Hungry Island ratified. The ownership of Hungry Island, located in Muscongus Bay, in the County of Lincoln, previously confirmed by the boundaries of the Town of Bremen to be in the Town of Bremen, is ratified and declared to be in the Town of Bremen.
