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**RESOLVE, Authorizing Improvements to Road to WCBB Transmitting  
Facilities in Litchfield.**

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**Road to WCBB transmitting facilities; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there is appropriated to the State Highway Commission the sum of \$31,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to aid in repairing the South Oak Hill Road, Route #1, in the Towns of Litchfield and Wales; said sum to be taken from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Towns of Litchfield and Wales are unable to provide the improvements needed to bring the road to the WCBB transmitter, in Litchfield, up to an adequate level of year around passability. The fact that the transmitter serves more than 50% of the population of Maine, and more than 70,000 public school children, through its television broadcasts, warrants that such improvements be undertaken by the State.
