STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Organization of Cemetery Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 13, § 1071, amended. Section 1071, of Title 13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1071. Incorporation. Persons of lawful age may organize themselves into a nonprofit-sharing corporation for the purpose of purchasing land for a burying ground and for the purpose of owning, maintaining and operating a cemetery or cemeteries, as provided in sections 901 and, 902 and 903 and may proceed in the manner and, except as restricted, with the powers provided in section 031.
