AN ACT Relating to Corporate Names.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 13, § 74, amended. Section 74 of Title 13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 74. Protection for corporate name. No corporation organizing or organized under chapters 1 to 21 shall assume, adopt or use the name of a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Maine, or a name so nearly resembling the name of such corporation as to be a colorable imitation thereof or calculated to deceive any person.'
