SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 436, L. D. 565, Bill, "An Act  
Providing for Safety Seat Belts for Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out the single quotation mark  
at the end of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following  
underlined paragraph:

"In any accident involving an automobile, the nonuse of  
seat belts by the driver of or passengers in the automobile shall  
not be admissable in evidence in any trial, civil or criminal,  
arising out of such accident."
