COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" To S. P. 195, L.D. 574, Bill, "An Act to
Provide Protection for Physically Abused Children."

Amend said Bill, in that part designated "§3852" by
striking out all of the 2nd line and inserting in place thereof
the following: 'licensed osteopathic physician, intern or resident,
licensed chiropractor having reasonable cause'

Further amend said Bill, in that part designated "§3853",
by inserting after the underlined word "physician" in the 5th
line the underlined words 'or licensed chiropractor'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part
designated "§3855"; and by renumbering that part designated "§3856"
to be '§3855'
