# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Part-Time Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 701, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 701 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The commission may grant part-time licenses for a period not in excess of 6 consecutive months in any calendar year.'
