**Appropriation to extend water and sewer systems on Indian Island. Re-
solved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the
General Fund the sum of \$10,000 to the Department of Health and Welfare to
extend the water and sewer systems of the Penobscot Indians on Indian Island.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

To protect the health and safety of the Indians on Indian Island the water and
sewer systems on the island should be extended.
