RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph T. Sewall of Boothbay Harbor for Land Damage.

Joseph T. Sewall; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to Joseph T. Sewall of Boothbay Harbor as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damages not compensated by the State Highway Commission to his real property caused during the reconstruction of highway Route #1 in Wiscasset, Lincoln County, during the years 1949 and 1950.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Land was taken from Mr. Sewall on both sides of his property on Route I in Wiscasset, plus the cutting of a birch tree which could not be replaced for over 1,000. His service station was out of business for over $4\frac{1}{2}$ months right in the busiest part of the season and sales were at the highest. The frontage of his service station was ruined and it will be necessary to rebuild or move the buildings in order to provide proper pumping space for cars and trucks.
