RESOLVE, in Favor of Lloyd Magoon of Mattawamkeag.

Lloyd Magoon; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$1,000 from the General Highway Fund to be paid to Lloyd Magoon, of Mattawamkeag, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for removing approximately 500 cords of firewood from the right-of-way taken by the State on the Mattawamkeag Road construction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Magoon signed an offer presented to him by an agent of the State Highway Commission agreeing to remove the firewood for the price of \$1,000 on or before November 1, 1959. Several days later the agent contacted Mr. Magoon again and told him that it would be appreciated if he would remove the firewood earlier than November 1st as it was holding up the job and would cost the State extra money if the job were delayed because of not having the right-of-way cleared. Mr. Magoon hired equipment and removed the wood forthwith having assurance from the agent that he would be paid the \$1,000 for doing so. Later Mr. Magoon was notified that the State would not pay him for removing the wood.
