AN ACT Relating to Election of Certain Municipal Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2055, amended. Section 2055 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2055. Annual meeting. Each town shall hold an annual meeting in March, at which time the following town officials shall be elected by ballot: Moderator, ~~clerk~~, selectmen, assessors ~~overscers of the poor, treasurer~~ and school committee. Other town officials may be elected by ballot or, if not so elected, they shall be appointed by the selectmen. A town official may not be elected on a motion to cast one ballot.'
