HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 471, L.D. 624, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Boards of Registration in Certain Towns."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

"Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, §43, sub-§§1-3, amended. Subsections 1 to 3 of section 43 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

- *1. Term of office. Each member nominated by the city committees and appointed by the municipal officers shall serve for 3 years and until his successor is appointed and sworn.

 The 3rd member appointed by the Governor municipal officers shall serve for 4 years and until his successor is appointed and sworn.
- 2. Chairman of the board. The 3rd member appointed by the Governor municipal officers is chairman of the board.
- 3. Vacancy. When there is a vacancy on the board, the municipal officers shall appoint a qualified person nominated by the city committee of the party of the former incumbent to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term.
- A. Exception. When there is a vacancy in the office of chairman of the board, the Governor, with the advice and eensent of the Council, municipal officers shall appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term.
