**AN ACT to Hold the Primary Election on the Second Tuesday after Labor Day.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, § 445, sub-§ 9, amended.** Subsection 9 of section 445 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**'9. When filed.** It must be filed with the Secretary of State on or before ~~April~~ **July** 1st of the election year in which it is to be used.'

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, § 448, amended.** Section 448 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 448. Time of election.** The primary election shall be held on the ~~3rd~~ **Monday of June 2nd Tuesday after Labor Day** of each general election year.'
