**AN ACT Relating to Area Directional Sign for Acadia National Park.**

---

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to aid Maine tourists in the summer of 1965 in finding one of Maine's finest recreational areas and in traveling to such area in the most convenient manner; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 23, § 1201, sub-§ 16, amended.** Subsection 16 of section 1201 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'16. **Acadia National Park-Route 3-Exit 15 or Interstate Route 95.'**

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
