AN ACT Relating to Signatures on Instruments to be Recorded.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 11, § 9-401-A, additional. Title 11 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 9-401-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 9-401-A. Typed signatures. On all instruments to be recorded under this Title, signatures shall also be typed on the instruments directly under the written signatures.’

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 33, § 667, additional. Title 33 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 667, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 667. Typed signatures. On all instruments to be recorded in the registry of deeds, signatures shall also be typed on the instruments directly under the written signatures.’
