### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Minimum Wages for Firemen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 663, sub-§ 7, additional. Section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 7, to read as follows:
- '7. Minimum wage for firemen. Members of municipal fire fighting departments, other than volunteer or call-departments, who are paid salaries or regular wages, are deemed to be employees within the meaning of this section, are covered by chapter 7, subchapter III.'
  - Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective May 1, 1966.
