COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 514, L.D. 667, Bill, "An Act
Providing for Vacation Time for Employees of City of
Lewiston."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 1-B. Vacation time for employees. An employee
who has worked one full year shall be entitled to 10 earned
working days of vacation. An employee who has worked 10
years shall be entitled to 15 earned working days of vacation.
This section shall apply to all employees of the City of
Lewiston, except firemen and policemen."
