COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 516, L.D. 669, Bill, "An Act
Amending the Charter of the City of Augusta."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting after the word "members" in the 3rd line from the end the underlined words 'present and voting'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out the underlined word "reasonable" in the last line and inserting in place thereof the underlined words and figure 'not more than 6'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 4, a new section, as follows:

"Sec. 5. P. & S. L., 1957, c. 169, Art. VII, §8, amended.

The 2nd sentence of section 8 of Article VII of chapter 169 of the private and special laws of 1957 is amended to read as follows:

No order providing for the issue of bonds shall be passed without public notice given by posting notice of the same in 2 public places in the City of Augusta, and publishing said notice in at least one daily newspaper circulated in said Augusta at least 2 weeks before final action by the city council, and the approval of 3/4 of all the members of the city council present and voting thereon.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the Referendum.
