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**AN ACT to Clarify the Charter of the Kennebec Water District.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1899, c. 200, § 1, repealed and replaced.** Section 1 of chapter 200 of the private and special laws of 1899, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 105 of the private and special laws of 1963, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**'Sec. 1. Incorporation.** The territory and people within the City of Waterville, and the Towns of Winslow and Fairfield, shall constitute a body politic and incorporate under the name of the Kennebec Water District for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of said district and of the Towns of Benton and Vassalboro and all said municipalities with pure water for domestic and all other lawful purposes. The records of the Kennebec Water District are public and meetings of the trustees shall be open.'
