STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 224, L. D. 683, Bill, "An Act Increasing Salary of Commissioner of Agriculture."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title: 'AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Commissioner of Agriculture and Deputy Secretary of State.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enecting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Sec. 1, R. S., T. 5, §81, amended. Section 81 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the first sentence of the 2nd paragraph the following new sentence:

'The Secretary of State may appoint the Deputy Secretary of State subject to the Personnel Law.'

Sec. 2. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that section 1 shall in no way affect the tenure of the office of the Deputy Secretary of State who shall receive a salary not less than the salary paid to him as of the effective date of this Act.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 7, §1, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 1 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'He (Commissioner of Agriculture) shall receive an annual salary of \$11,000 \$12,000.'

Sec. 4. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$750 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of Section 3."
