AN ACT Exempting Boats and Boat Motors from Property Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 149I, additional. Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 149I, as follows:

‘Sec. 149I. Municipal tax exemption on boats. Boats and boat motors shall be exempt from municipal taxation as personal property.’
