STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Membership on Boards and Commissions in City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XVI, § 2-A, additional. Article XVI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 2-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. Nonpartisan members of boards and commissions. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Act, as amended, to the contrary all members of boards and commissions shall be chosen regardless of political affiliation.'
