STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for Paid Holidays for Employees of City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XVI, § 1-A, additional. Article XVI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 1-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 1-A. Paid holidays. All city employees, except policemen and firemen, shall have the following paid holidays: New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday, Patriots Day, Memorial Day, Good Friday, National Election Day, Municipal Election Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and State Election Day.'
