STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to False Identification of Minors Under Liquor Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 28, § 401, sub-§ 2-A, additional. Section 401 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 2-A, to read as follows:
- '2-A. Sales to minors. Licenses shall not be revoked or suspended for sale to a minor, if the minor has been found guilty of presenting false identification. This subsection shall not apply in those cases where the licensee has not diligently attempted to determine the authenticity of the minor's identification.'
