AN ACT Relating to Notice of Hearing on Railroad Safety Matters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1198, additional. Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1198, to read as follows:

'Sec. 1198. Railroad safety matters. On any matter pertaining to railroad clearances or on any matter wherein the safety of railroad trainmen is concerned, the Public Utilities Commission shall, at least 10 days before the date of hearing on such matter or matters, serve a notice of the time and place of said hearing by mailing a registered letter, postage prepaid, to the state representative of the Legislative Board of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen. To effectuate the purpose of this section, it shall be the duty of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen to file with the Public Utilities Commission, in writing, the name and address of said state representative.'
