STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide Adequate Illumination of Switching Leads in Railroad Yards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1198, additional. Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1198 to read as follows:

'Sec. 1198. Illuminated switching leads. In order to provide maximum safety to train and yard service employees, who are required to work on or about moving railroad freight equipment, all railroad companies operating in the State of Maine shall have all switching leads in yards, where continuous switching service is normally performed, reasonably and adequately illuminated during the hours of darkness.'
