STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Retirement Benefits of Certain Retired Superintendents of Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Retired superintendents of school; retirement benefits increased. The retirement benefits of those superintendents of schools, still living, who were retired as of the effective date of the Retirement Act, by order of the Governor and Council, shall be increased by \$600 per year; such increases to become effective on the first day of the month following the effective date of this Act.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$3,000 to the Maine State Retirement System for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
