**AN ACT** Relating to Retirement Benefits for Fire Fighters Under State Retirement System.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1095, amended.** Section 1095 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

‘Each fire fighter, including the chief of a fire department, shall be required to contribute 7% of earnable compensation beginning with the first full payroll period after the effective date of this Act as long as he is employed as a fire fighter.’

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 1121, sub-§ 8, additional.** Section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 8, to read as follows:

‘8. Fire fighters. Any member who is a fire fighter, including the chief of a fire department, who has at least 25 years of service as a fire fighter shall be permitted to retire upon attainment of age 55. The service retirement allowance shall be equal to 66  $\frac{2}{3}$ % of his current final compensation.’
