RESOLVE, Providing Pension for Emily Withee of Vassalboro.

Emily Withee; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$35 per month be granted to Emily Withee, of Vassalboro, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1965 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Withee receives a pension of \$73.13 per month from the Federal Government and a \$12 general law pension from the State. She has to pay \$60 per month for board and \$4 per month to keep her hearing aid in condition; also has to pay doctor's bills and medical bills.
