STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Regulating Digging of Clams in Wells, York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

License required to dig or take clams in Wells. No person shall, in the Town of Wells in the County of York, dig or take clams unless license has been granted to him by the municipal officers of said town, who are authorized to grant and issue such licenses and fix the fee therefor. No license shall be granted or issued except to a resident of York County.
