IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of the Adjutant General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 25, § 712, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 712 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The Adjutant General shall receive an annual salary of \$10,000 \$13,500. He shall receive no other fee, emolument or perquisite.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$2,620 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$3,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
