RESOLVE, Providing for a Study of the State Personnel and Retirement Systems.

Study of Personnel and Retirement Systems. Resolved: That the Personnel Board be authorized to employ professional consultants to obtain the information necessary to determine whether changes are needed to improve the State Personnel laws, special emphasis in the study to be given to the areas of classification and salary, and the State Retirement System.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The laws governing the employment of State Personnel should be reviewed from time to time and evaluation made as to their effectiveness to serve the interests of government as well as the welfare of employees. A thorough review of the State classification plan has not been undertaken since 1950 and is much needed.
