COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 560, L.D. 730, Bill, "An
Act Providing for an additional Trial Term for York
County."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 4, §110, sub-§16, repealed and replaced.

Subsection 16 of section 110 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes
is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'16. York: At Alfred on the first Tuesdays of January,
March, May, September and November, but the criminal business
of said county shall be transacted at the terms held on the
first Tuesdays of January, May and September, together with
civil business, and criminal appeal cases from the District
Court in York County may be transacted at the March term.
The grand jury shall attend only at the January, May and
September terms unless specially summoned by order of a justice
of said court.'"
