IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for an Additional Trial Term for York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 4, § 110, sub-§ 16, amended. Subsection 16 of section 110 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '16. York: At Alfred on the first Tuesdays of January, March, May, September and November, but the criminal business of said county shall be transacted at the terms held on the first Tuesdays of January, March, May and September, together with civil business.'
