AN ACT Providing Aroostook County Funds for Maine-Quebec Highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. Funds. Aroostook County is authorized to raise \$60,000 per year for a period of 5 years beginning in 1966 for the purpose of defraying expenses for land damages and the purchase of rights-of-way to be incurred in the construction of a highway from Asland to the Quebec border at a point near d'Aaquam, P. Q.

Sec. 2. Application. Moneys raised under this Act by Aroostook County shall be segregated from all other county funds and shall be used only for the purposes of this Act. Any unexpended balances shall be used to decrease county tax assessments after 1972.
