STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 10th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Oxford County: County commissioners, \$1,800 \$2,000; chairman, \$2,000 \$2,200; clerk of courts, \$4,200 \$4,800; county attorney, \$4,500 \$5,500; county treasurer, \$2,700 \$3,200; sheriff, \$4,300 \$5,200; register of deeds, eastern district, \$4,200; \$4,800; western district, \$2,400 \$3,000; judge of probate, \$4,000 \$4,800.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to provide for the increase in salary of the county attorney of Oxford County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
