## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officers of Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 13th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sagadahoc County: County commissioners, \$1,000; clerk of courts, \$4,200; county attorney, \$4,000; county treasurer, \$1,700 \$2,200; sheriff, \$4,100; register of deeds, \$4,200 \$4,700; judge of probate, \$3,000; register of probate, \$3,800.'
