AN ACT Relating to Temporary Number Plates for Dealers of Camp and House Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 340, amended. Section 340 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘Sec. 340. Temporary number plates; notification; cost. A manufacturer or dealer or holder of a transporter registration certificate **or a dealer in camp and house trailers** or boat trailer registration may, upon the sale or exchange of a motor vehicle or boat trailer **or camp or house trailer**, attach to rear plate holder of such motor vehicle or boat trailer **or camp or house trailer** a temporary registration plate, and the purchaser of such motor vehicle or boat trailer **or camp or house trailer** may operate the same for a period not to exceed 10 consecutive days thereafter without payment of a regular fee. If the purchaser of such motor vehicle or boat trailer **or camp or house trailer** is a nonresident member of the armed services, said purchaser may operate the same for a period not to exceed 20 consecutive days thereafter without payment of a regular fee. A temporary registration plate may not be used on a loaded truck without a written permit from the Secretary of State.

A manufacturer or dealer or holder of a transporter registration certificate or boat trailer registration certificate **or a dealer in camp and house trailers** shall, upon attaching a temporary registration plate to a motor vehicle or boat trailer **or camp or house trailer** sold or exchanged by him, mark thereon the date when said license expires and immediately notify the Secretary of said sale or exchange, giving the name and address of the purchaser, the number of the temporary plate and such further information as the Secretary of State may require. The mark-

ings required by this paragraph to be placed on a temporary registration plate shall be made not less than one inch in height, with indelible or waterproof ink.

The Secretary of State may issue temporary registration plates to bona fide dealers or holders of transporter registration certificates or boat trailer registration certificates **or to dealers in camp and house trailers** who request them under such rules and regulations as he shall deem necessary, and shall receive for them 50c per plate.'
