SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 238, L. D. 748, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Number of School Directors in a School Administrative
District."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined
sentence of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:
"In the event the number of directors is not evenly divisible by 3,
the terms of directors represented by the integer obtained by dividing
the number of directors by 3 shall be determined by the preceding
sentence; if one member remains, he shall serve a 3-year term; if
2 members remain, one shall serve a 3-year term and one shall serve
a 2-year terms, to be determined by lot.'"
