SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 244, L. D. 754, Bill, "An Act  
Regulating the Running and Training of Dogs in Training  
Areas Enclosed with Rabbit-Proof Fences."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 2 sentences  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

"No person shall hunt on a licensed dog training area ~~except the~~  
~~owner of the lands who may hunt unprotected birds and animals only.~~  
~~The Department of Inland Fisheries and Game may make rules regulating~~  
~~the use of such areas.~~"
