SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 244, L. D. 754, Bill, "An Act

Regulating the Running and Training of Dogs in Training

Areas Enclosed with Rabbit-Proof Fences."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 2 sentences and inserting in place thereof the following:

"No person shall hunt on a licensed dog training area except-the owner-of-the-lands-who-may-hunt-unprotected-birds-and-animals-only:

The-Department-of-Inland-Fisheries-and-Game-may-make-rules-regulating the-use-of-such-areas:'"
